Scholarship Program Continues Growth

Since 2013, SICF has been working on its scholarship program, which now includes 13 different funds. In 2018 the scholarship funds awarded over \$78,000. Over the 6 year period, SICF has been able to award scholarships totaling over \$258,000 to more than 220 students.

The 2 newest funds, Merwin & Villa Spencer and the George and Goldie Mae Hall scholarship funds will make their first scholarship award in 2019. Through all of the scholarship funds SICF looks forward to helping more students in the efforts to further their education in preparation for their careers.
